2021 Pegi Bannan - Volleyball Player Scholarship

Overview

The West Virginia-Ohio Volleyball Officials Association will offer a one-time \$500 award to a graduating senior volleyball player that plays for one of the schools that the association provides services.

To be eligible to receive the award, the player must enroll in an accredited college or university.

Qualifications

Applicant must graduate from one of the schools that the association services. These schools include: Barnesville, Bellaire, Bridgeport, Brooke, Buckeye Local, Cameron, East Richland Christian, Harrison Central, Indian Creek, John Marshall, Linsly, Madonna, Martins Ferry, Monroe Central, Oak Glen, River, St.Clairsville, St.John, Shadyside, Steubenville, Steubenville Catholic, Union Local, Weir, Wheeling Central, and Wheeling Park.

Applicant must show outstanding sportsmanship-like behavior on and off the court of play.

Applicant must provide the complete application to the scholarship committee postmarked on or before February 1, 2021. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

Award Presentation and Payment

The scholarship winner will be notified in April, 2021 of their selection. Official presentation will be at the OVAC Banquet of Champions in May, 2021. Details will be forwarded prior to the banquet. Payment will be sent after completion of the first semester to assist on fees for the second semester. Documentation of award can be forwarded upon request if you also receive a matching scholarship offer.

Scholarship Application Criteria and Checklist

Each applicant for the West Virginia-Ohio Volleyball Officials Scholarship must submit to the West Virginia-Ohio Volleyball Officials Association a completed application packet. Any packet not postmarked by the **deadline date of February 1, 2021** or received incomplete will not be considered for the award.

The complete packet will include the items listed below. Any applicant is free to submit any other information she deems might be pertinent to the committee in their selection process.

- Completed application form
- Applicant's photo that will not be returned (optional)
- Official copy of current high school transcript
- A personal statement from the applicant (up to two pages in length). This statement should include:
 - A paragraph regarding what volleyball means to you
 - How volleyball has made you a better citizen, and
 - What an official means to you and the game of volleyball
- Submit two (2) references: one from a volleyball coach, the other from a teacher or counselor.
